Transmission and Distribution Utilities (TDU) set the non-demand and demand classifications of each meter. That classification is based on the peak amount of electricity used at any given point during the month, also known as demand. Non-demand meters have a demand that's less than or equal to 10 KW while demand meters have a demand that's greater than 10 KW. Encourage your customer to know the demand of their meter by viewing their current bill with them or advising them to contact their TDU. TDU Pass-Through charges for delivering electricity will be passed through to the customers without markup. For demand meters, the average price per kWh is based on an estimated peak demand assuming a 30% load factor. This price disclosure is an estimate and the actual price you paid will vary based on the actual usage, demand, and TDU charges.
